Circular Memorandum

It is proposed to fill up vacancies in the following ranks in the Intelligence Bureau under the Ministry of Home Affairs on absorption/deputation, (including short term contract basis) as mentioned below. The educational qualifications, experience and other eligibility conditions for the post are furnished below.

1. Deputy Director/Tech (3 vacancies), Group A, Gazetted, Non-Ministerial (Level-13 A in the Pay Matrix) to be filled up by deputation (Including short term contract).

Eligibility : Deputation (including short term contract)

Officers of the Central Government or State Governments or Union territories or Public Sector Undertakings or Recognized Research Institutions or Universities or Semi-Government Organizations or Autonomous bodies or Statutory Organizations :

(a) (i) holding analogous post on a regular basis in the parent cadre/ department, or
(ii) with 2 years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in Level 13 in the Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; and

(b) possessing the following educational qualification, namely : -

(i) Bachelor Degree in Engineering [B.E or B.Tech or B.Sc(Engg)] awarded by a recognized University in the fields of Electronics or Electronics and Communication or Electronics and Telecommunications; or Associate Membership of Institute of Engineers (AMIE) in Electronics and Communications Engineering; or Graduate ship awarded by Associate Membership of Institute of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers (AMIETE) in Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering; or Master of Science in Physics with Electronics or Telecommunications; or Bachelor Degree in Engineering [B.E or B.Tech or B.Sc(Engg)] awarded by a recognized University in the fields of Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Computer Technology, Computer Science & Engineering, information Technology or Software Engineering; or Master of Computer Applications (MCA) after three years Bachelor of Science in Physics; or Master of Science (Information Technology) or Master of Science (Computer Science/Computer Application) or Master of Science (Software) from a recognized University/Institute; and

(ii) twelve years' experience in research and development or manufacture or application in the area of telecommunication equipment or computer or telecommunication network or signal monitoring or Communication Intelligence (COMINT) or Technical Intelligence (TECHINT) or Information Technology (IT).

Desirable Skills :

(i) Project Management Skills (IT/Civicon/Satellite Network/Data Centres)

(ii) GPS, GIS

(iii) Ground Segment

Note-1 : The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation (including short term contract). Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note-2 : Period of deputation (including short term contract) including period of deputation (including short term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization /department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years. Eligibility : Promotion/deputation (Composite method).

Officers under the Central Government : -

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/ department; or
(ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in Pay Band PB-3, Rs. 15600-39100 plus Grade pay of 5400/ or equivalent in the parent cadre/department: and

(i) A pass in Subordinate Accounts Service or equivalent examination conducted by the organized Accounts department of the Central Government.

(ii) Training in Cash and Accounts work in the Institute of Secretariat Training and Management and three years' experience in cash, accounts and budget work.

Note-1: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall not exceed three years.
